The Reading Primary School Music Festival will be taking place on Tuesday 13th March at the Hexagon. All pupils in Year 6 will attend the rehearsals as set out below:

Friday 24th February at St. Anne's Primary School from 9.45 am – 11.15 am

Friday 9th March at St. Anne's Primary School from 9.45 am – 11.15 am

Tuesday 13th March at the Hexagon from 10.00 am – 12.30 pm

Once again we have been successful in gaining sufficient places for all our Year 6 pupils to participate in the Music Festival. To assist with the learning of the words, each child will be supplied with a CD and all the song words, this will cost £1.

Three pupils from each of the participating schools are allowed to audition for solo parts, you will be informed if your child has been selected to attend the auditions. If your child has been selected you will need to take them to the auditions for soloists which will be held during the afternoon of Monday 6th February at St. Edward's School, Tilehurst Road, Reading. Parking is available on Western Elms Avenue, with a side gate which leads into the school.

We will walk to and from the rehearsals at St. Anne's Primary School and will travel by coach or staff and parent cars to the final rehearsal at the Hexagon that is held on the morning of the Music Festival.

Children will need to be at the Hexagon for 6.30 pm on the 13th. Pupils should wear dark trousers (not jeans or a dark skirts and colourful T-shirts (without logos please). A letter will be given out at a later date so that tickets may be purchased.
